SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

- Two Operational Branches:
 - Collections Erica Gilbert
 - Cleansing Denver Stevens



COLLECTIONS BRANCH - ROLES

- Refuse Removal in Wheelie Bin:
 - Formal Residential
 - Formal Non-residential (business)
 - Kerbside
- Frequency of removal :
 - Residential : once per week
 - Sectional Title : 3 times per week
 - Business: up to 5 times per week
- Bin Logistics :
 - Bin deliveries new applications
 - Bin Replacements stolen or damaged
- Adhoc Services : garden refuse
- Waste Minimization separation at source



COLLECTIONS BRANCH - DROP-OFF FACILITIES

- Strategy: Drop-off within 7 km radius
- Use by residents; garden services and small building contractors
- 1.5 tonne maximum bakkie / trailer based on carrying capacity
 - Recycling
 - Builders Rubble crushing
 - Garden Refuse chipped and compost
 - Garage Waste -
 - Non-hazardous waste that cannot be disposed of in the refuse bin
- Use of the site is free.



CLEANSING BRANCH - ROLES

- Street Cleaning:
 - Boundary to Boundary
 - Sweeping
 - Litter Picking
 - Litter Bins
- Beach Cleaning
- River Banks
- Business / Industrial area
- Informal Traders
- Illegal Dumping
- Informal Settlements
- Carcass Removal : public space



Cleansing - Specialised

- Mechanical Interventions:
 - -Street Sweeping
 - Sanitise/Disinfect certain areas
 - Beach Cleaning
 - Carcass Removal



Illegal Dumping & Litter: Who does what?

Function	Responsible Branch/Department
In the River/Canal	Stormwater
On the River/Canal Bank	Cleansing
Public Open Space	Cleansing
Road Reserve	Cleansing
Fenced Park	Parks
Recreational Area	Custodian Department/Branch
Beach	Cleansing
Alleyway/Lane (open)	Cleansing
Alleyway Lane (closed)	Adjacent properties
Mountain	Sanparks
Courtyards at flats (Council Rental Units)	Human Settlements
